ECCA National Cross Country Championships 2024

The 2024 ECCA Cross Country Championship are taking place at

Weston Park, Weston Under Lizard Staffordshire TF11 8LE

The venue is 1000 acres of parkland situated on the A5 and the Postcode covers the whole parkland. For anyone with the what three words app on their mobile phone the Main gate to the park has the three word code **Promotion/Visitor/Blazed**.

It is suggested that athletes attending from both north and south should travel on the M6 getting off at **Junction 12** (Gailey) and head West towards Telford on the A5. The Park is approximately 8 miles from the M6 junction. Athletes traveling from the West should join the A5 either from Telford or the A41.

For Athletes traveling by coach or mini bus the car park for these vehicles is at the Granary Resturant. Coming from the M6 it is about 1 mile before the main entrance. What Three Words code **Friends/Nudge/Tiger**

Mobile signal within the park is not particularly strong and as such card readers will not be available to accept payment for the car parking. So car parking will be £5 **cash** or **prebooked**. On entering the park there will be three lanes accepting payment. Cars will then turn immediately right onto the car parking area. Clubs tents will be situated adjacent to the car park so there will be no need for drop off permits.

Coaches and mini buses will have to prebook their parking in order for Traffic Management to know spaces needed. This parking will be on hard standing. Any clubs on coaches or mini buses be aware that there will be a walk from the coach park to the club tent area. It is not possible for coaches or minibuses to get any closer to the tented area for drop off.
