ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

All competing athletes must be first claim members of their club and registered with England Athletics. Failure to provide a valid registration number on your entry form will result in the entry being returned. This rule will be rigorously applied to all SEAA Championships and applies to all age groups.

The Club Official submitting the team entry form/s is responsible for ensuring the eligibility (age and first claim) of the entrants and the suitability of the event for those entered.

Club's wishing to take part must be affiliated to England Athletics and the SEAA and have stated their intention to take part in Cross Country events.

IT IS SEAA POLICY TO NOT ACCEPT ANY LATE ENTRIES.

All athletes must have a Southern Area Qualification in accordance with Rule G2 (21) S6 (2)

RULE G2 (21) S 6 UKA SUPPLEMENT COUNTY, DISTRICT AND AREA QUALIFICATIONS

- (2) English Area Championships and Representation
- (a) An Area qualification to compete shall be acquired as follows:
- By birth (See also Rule G2 S4(1).
- By nine months' continuous bona fide residence within the Area boundary immediately prior to the date of competition.
- By nine months' service in HM Forces stationed within the Area boundary immediately prior to the date of the competition.
- (b) A student at school, college or university does not acquire a residential qualification by residence during term time alone. An Area, though, may, at its discretion, relax the residential qualification in the case of Under 20 and younger athletes, and of Seniors in residence at college or university, but any competition shall not be deemed to have established an Area qualification.
- (c) No athlete is allowed to compete in the Championships of more than one Area Association in any one nine month period.

By submitting an entry to any SEAA Championship, whether by paper or online, you acknowledge that you are **bound by UKA Anti-Doping rules**.

CONDITIONS & DETAILS

Meeting will be held under UKA Rules.

All competing athletes must be first claim members of their club and registered with England Athletics.

Clubs are required to complete and sign a declaration form on the day, from names entered.

Team declarations must be submitted at least 30 minutes before the start of the race and no changes are permitted after that time.

Only names entered may compete, no substitutions are allowed.

Medals will be awarded for 1st/2nd/3rd teams in all races.

QUALIFICATIONS

The Championships shall be open to any first claim member of any club registered for cross country to England Athletics and whose headquarters is domiciled in the Greater London area plus any individual athlete provided that the individual is either;

- (a) he/she was born in the Greater London area.
- (b) has not less than one year's bona fide residence in Greater London.
- (c) has not less than one year's continuous full-time employment in Greater London.
- (d) has not less than one year's full-time attendance at an educational establishment in Greater London.

and

(e) he/she is 17 or over on 1st September 2023

and

(f) is registered with England Athletics

and

(g) team entries must be first claim members of that club.

Anyone whose transfer has been approved by England Athletics but is ineligible for team competition may be entered as an individual.

The Greater London area comprises;

The City of London, The London Boroughs of Barking and Dagenham, Barnet, Bexley, Brent, Bromley, Camden, Croydon, Ealing, Enfield, Greenwich, Hackney, Hammersmith and Fulham, Harrow, Haringey, Havering, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Islington, Kensington and Chelsea, Kingston Upon Thames, Lambeth, Lewisham, Merton, Newham, Redbridge, Richmond Upon Thames, Southwark, Sutton, Tower Hamlets, Waltham Forest, Wandsworth, and the City of Westminster.

Medals will be awarded to the first three individual runners, members of the first three "A" teams, the first master (man over 40 and woman over 40 on the 18th November 2023 and the first Under 20 on 31st August 2023) in both the men's and women's events. Clubs can enter any number of teams.

Entry fee is £8.00 per individual (No team fee)

Chip Timing will be used. Please ensure all chips are returned at the end of your race, or you may be charged a lost chip fee.

In accordance with UKA rules age is determined by age on the day of Competition.

Individual awards will be made in five year age bands up to 69. Gold, Silver and Bronze (1st, 2nd and 3rd)

Team awards (3 to score) (1st, 2nd, 3rd) awards will be in ten year age bands (40/50/60)

Entry Fee is £10.00 per person (NO TEAM FEE)

CONDITIONS & DETAILS

Meeting will be held under UKA Rules.

Only one team per club in each age band will be eligible for an award.

All competing athletes must be first claim members of their club and registered with England Athletics.

Anyone whose transfer has been approved by England Athletics but is ineligible for team competition may be entered as an individual

Entries on the day will not be accepted.

An athlete may <u>ONLY</u> compete in one age group – e.g. an over 50 woman may compete for the over 40 women's team but may <u>ONLY</u> score as an individual in that particular age group i.e. over 40 team.

Runners, who wish to count for a younger team instead of their own age group, MUST declare this on the entry form and this CANNOT be changed on the DAY. <u>This means that you can only qualify for the medal in the team race for which you are entered.</u>

Athletes must run in their correct age groups.

Counties may enter and run more than one team in each age group, but this must be stated on the entry form.

CONDITIONS & DETAILS

Meeting will be held under UKA Rules.

Entry fee is £45.00 per team.

For each team, 12 may be entered from which 8 to run and 4 to score, numbers will be issued to the declared runners on the day. All athletes MUST be eligible to represent their County by birth or residence. Dates of births must be declared.

All competitors will score and be recorded in the results.

All competing athletes must be first claim members of their club and registered with England Athletics.

Clubs are required to complete and sign a declaration form on the day, from names entered.

Aged at least 20 on 31st August 2023

Team declarations must be submitted at least 30 minutes before the start of the race and no changes are permitted after that time. Only names entered before the closing date may compete, no substitutions are allowed. Competitors cannot be declared for more than one team.

Medals will be awarded for 1st / 2nd / 3rd individuals and 1st / 2nd / 3rd "A" teams in all races.

Only one team award, per County, in each race.

In the event of extreme weather where the event must be cancelled, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Chip Timing will be used.

Failure to return your chip may result in you being charged.

<u>SENIOR MEN'S RACE - Note to Team</u> Managers and Individual Athletes.

You are respectfully reminded this is a Championship event. In the interests of health and safety of our officials and volunteers we have found it necessary to have a cut off time. If athletes have not started their 3rd lap by 50 minutes they are advised they will be unlikely to complete the course in 90 minutes when times will stop being recorded. Any runner deciding to continue

against this advice will be running at their own risk.

CONDITIONS & DETAILS

Meeting will be held under UKA and ECCA Rules.

Clubs wishing to take part must be affiliated to England Athletics and the SEAA and have stated their intention to take part in Cross Country events. All athletes entered MUST be FIRST CLAIM MEMBERS of their club. Anyone whose transfer has not yet been approved by England Athletics is ineligible for team competition but may be entered as an individual. All athletes must be registered with England Athletics.

SEAA medals will be awarded to the first three placed competitors and the scoring team members of the first three placed "A" teams in each group. A plaque will be awarded to the winning team and the winning individual in each race.

In the event of a meeting or event being cancelled, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.
