# **ECCA National Cross Country Championships 2024**

**The 2024 ECCA Cross Country Championships are taking place at**

**Western Park, Weston Under Lizard Staffordshire TF11 8LE**

Western Park, Western-under-Lizard is situated on the south side of the A5

Vehicles coming from the North and South should use the M6 and get off at Junction 12 Gailey and take the A5 sign posted Telford. From the South **DO NOT** follow sat nav along the M54.

Coming from the East use the A5 and head for Telford. The Park is Situated about 7 miles from the motorway.

The Gate for these vehicles to enter park is known as Shrewsbury Gates.

What3words code is **Promotion.Visitor.Blazed**

Anyone with tent drop off permit enter through Shrewsbury Gate and they will be directed to the Tentage area. Coaches and mini buses will not be allowed to enter Shrewsbury Gate for tent drop off.
